Geographic area names are followed by either their HPS or census code.

1. A " " following an MCD name denotes a false MCD. A " " following a place name indicates that a false MCD exists with the same name and HPS code on the place; the false MCD label is in parentheses.

2. Place label color corresponds to the place US color.

3. Census tracts are identified by an up to four-digit integer number and may have an optional two-digit suffix; for example 23 or 1437.82. The census tract codes consist of six digits with an implied decimal between the fourth and fifth digit corresponding to the basic census tract number, with leading zeros, and trailing zeros for census tracts without a suffix. The number examples above would have codes of 902300 and 143702, respectively.

Due to space limitations, some road names, along with other feature and geography names on the map, may not be shown.

All legal boundaries and names are as of January 1, 2020. The boundaries shown on this map are for Census Bureau statistical data collection and tabulation purposes only; their depiction and designation for statistical purposes does not constitute a determination of jurisdictional authority or rights of ownership or entitlement.
